Knitted Paper Chains

Knitted paper chains are perfect for using up small bits of leftover yarn. Unlike traditional paper chains they can be packed away at the end of the season and re-used year after year.


Materials

Yarn leftovers (double knit) or Aran Knitting needles (4mm) Tapestry Needle Scissors

Pattern (for each link)

Cast on 30 stitches Knit 6 rows Cast off knitwise

Making Up



Bend the knitting into a loop and sew the ends together. Work the loose ends of yarn into the reverse side of the fabric and trim neatly. This is the first link in your chain. Take your next piece of knitting and poke it through the previous link. Bend it into a loop and sew up as for the first. Keep adding links until your knitted chain is 2 metres long (unstretched).

Wool Colours

Please use two or three wools to match our different colour themes.

Holly: red and green



Starry Sky: warm yellow and blue



Shimmer: white and silver



Frost: pale blue, dark blue, white



Plum pudding: pink, blue, burgundy



Christmas stocking: red, green, white
