Remembrance Robins give you the opportunity to dedicate a beautiful clay robin to serve as a reminder to a much loved and missed individual.


The robins are handmade and painted by patients and those important to them, our staff, volunteers, and supporters. Every robin is as unique as the person they in memory of.

Starlight Stroll

Remember your loved one and commemorate their memory by taking part in our 6 mile Starlight Stroll.

Walkers Illuminate the way with their personalised Hospice lantern as they make their way through the beautifully lit Dunorlan Park. Once back at the Hospice, participants lay down their lanterns and light up the labyrinth, taking a moment to remember their loved one.
