



Stitch-a-Stocking



Knitting Pattern

You will need:

- 1 pair of UK 8/4mm size needles
- Double knitting yarn
- Ribbon, or similar, to create a loop

Pattern

Cast on 24 stitches

Work 4 rows in K1,P1 rib

Work 18 rows in st-st

Shape heel:

Row 1: K14 sts, turn

Row 2: P4 sts, turn

Row 3: K6 sts, turn

Row 4: P8 sts, turn

Row 5: K10 sts, turn

Row 6: P12 sts, turn

Row 7: K14 sts, turn

Row 8: P16 sts, turn

Row 9: K18 sts, turn

Row 10: P20 sts, turn

Row 11: Knit to the end of the row

Beginning with a P row, work 10 rows in st-st

Shape toe:

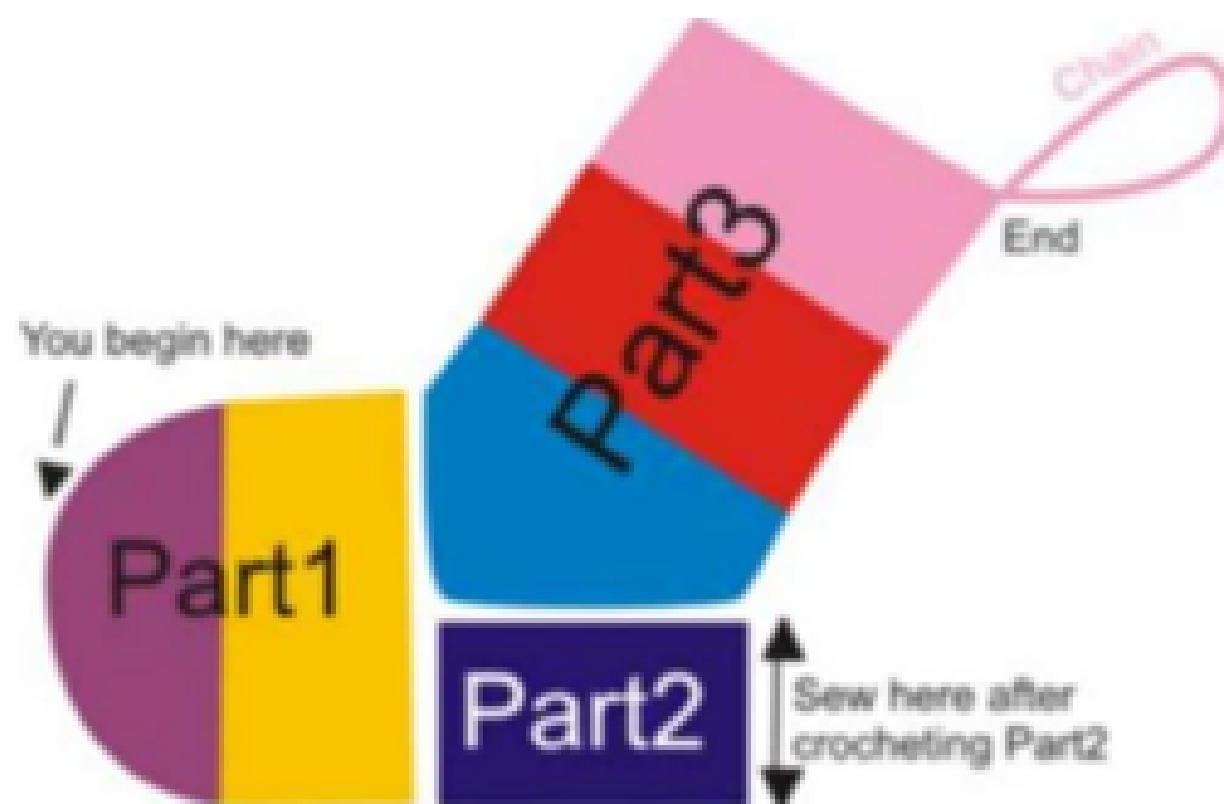
Row 1: P2tog 12 times (12 sts left on needle)

Row 2: K2tog 6 times (6 sts left on needle)

Break off yarn, leaving enough to thread through the remaining stitches, pull tight and fasten off.

Sew up the side seam & attach ribbon.

Crochet Pattern



Part 1

Round 1: 5sc into magic ring (5)

Round 2: 2sc in each st around (10sc)

Round 3: 1sc in first st, 2sc in next st repeat *1sc, 2sc* to complete round (15sc)

Rounds 4-7: 1sc in each st (15sc)

Part 2

Row 1-3: 1sc in each of next 8st ch1 turn

Row 4: 1sc in each of next 8st

Fold heel in half

Part 3

Round 1: work 4sc into edge of heel, 1sc in next 7sc of toe, 4sc in other edge of heel

Round 2: 1sc in each st around (15sc)

Round 3-10: repeat round 2 (15sc)

Cut yarn and sew in ends

Loop: ch15 and sew to top of stocking



Sewing Pattern

- Grab a festive piece of fabric and fold it in half
- Take the template below and place the long straight edge on the folded line of the fabric
- Cut out your stocking shape
- Turn your stocking inside out (right sides together)
- Sew from the edge of the fold around the heel to the toe, and up to the top of the stocking
- Make sure to leave a gap at the top to fit some treats inside and turn it back out
- Fold over the top seam, iron it flat and decorate as festively as you like!
- Finally, sew two ends of a ribbon to the top to make a hanging loop
