Materials

- 3.25mm knitting needles
- Darning needle
- Oddments of D.K yarn
- Googly eyes or oddments of
- Black yarn for eyes

Abbreviations

- Garter stitch knit every row.
- **K1, P1** Knit 1, Purl 1
- **K2tog** Knit 2 stitches together.
- Inc 1 stitch increase one stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.



Body

- Using 3.25mm needles and any coloured DK yarn, cast on 16 stitches and work 7 rows in K2, P2 rib, or if preferred K1, P1 rib.
- Inc 1 stitch at beginning of next row continue in rib to last stitch, Inc 1 stitch. (18 stitches on needle)
- Proceed in garter stitch until work measures
 3.5 inches from cast on edge, ending with a right-side row.
- K2tog, knit to the last 2 stitches, K2tog (16 stitches)
- Work 8 rows in K2, P2 rib, or if preferred K1, P1 rib (to match the beginning of the work) then cast off in rib.

Head

 Using 3.25mm needles and your chosen coloured yarn, cast on 12 stitches and proceed in garter stitch until work measures 2 inches then cast off.

Tail

 Using 3.25mm needles and the same-coloured DK yarn used to create the body cast on 12 stitches then cast off leaving a long piece of yarn for joining the tail to the body.

Making Up

- Fold the lambs' body over in half, right sides together and sew both side seams. Turn right side out.
- Fold the lambs' head diagonally creating a triangular shape and sew around edges to secure.
- Pinch the two top corners of the head then wrap yarn 3 or 4 times around the corners to create the shape of ears and secure.
- Sew the lambs' head to the body and either stick on two googly eyes or embroider from black yarn.
- Attach the tail to the body then twist the tail between your finger and thumb to create a slight curling effect. Insert a crème egg!
